

**ORDINANCE NO. 2023-01**  
**ORDINANCE TO AMEND SEC. 90-97 OF CHAPTER 90 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE**  
**OFF STREET PARKING LOTS**

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF KEWASKUM, WASHINGTON COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DO  
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** That Section 90-97 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Kewaskum, relating to Off Street Parking Lots, should be amended as follows:


**Sec. 90-97. Off-street parking lots.**

- (a) Off-street parking shall be permitted in properly designated off-street lots in the village. Those lots are designated as follows:
  - (1) Municipal Building parking lot, Railroad Street parking lot between Main Street and 2nd Street.
  - (2) River Hill Park parking lot, Riverview Drive west side curbed area adjacent to 1155 Riverview Drive.
  - (3) Downtown parking lot, adjacent to the Municipal Building Annex, 1308 Fond du Lac Avenue.
  - (4) Kewaskum Kiwanis Community Park, 1601 Brooklane Drive. (Seasonal with specific permission.)
- (b) The village reserves the right to limit the number of vehicles allowed in any lot, to designate specific area allowed for parking, and to restrict vehicles by weight and size, so as to not interfere with the routine business of the village.
- (c) All vehicles are to be moved once every 24-hour period and are to be currently licensed, registered vehicles.
- (d) The fee for such overnight winter, spring, summer and fall parking shall be \$10.00 per month, and permits therefor shall be obtained at the Administration office. The permit received must be displayed in the front window of the vehicle, left lower/driver's side of the dash.

**Section 2.** Severability. The several sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the Ordinance. The remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other Ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.
