



REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION FROM USE OF CARTS FOR GARBAGE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION

This application is a request for exemption from the Village of Kewaskum requirement to use 96-gallon wheeled carts for the collection of household garbage and recycling items. This exemption may be requested by a licensed physician on behalf of a patient who would be unable to use the 96-gallon wheeled garbage and recycling carts due to a physical condition or medical problem. If the request is granted, the Village of Kewaskum will notify the applicant in writing that they should continue to place their garbage and recycling in the 96-gallon carts and should locate the carts outside their garage on garbage day where the contractor, Veolia, can access them. Veolia will place a permanent medical exemption sticker on the carts, wheel them curb-side for collection and return them to their original location. **Please allow a minimum of five business days for processing this exemption request.**

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Kewaskum Starts Automated Trash Collection

Garbage collection in the Village of Kewaskum will be switching to fully automated collection for both trash and single-stream recycling beginning with your regularly scheduled pickup on Wednesday, December 9, 2009. This means that a garbage truck will pull up to the curb in front of your residence and by use of a mechanical arm system, will pick up, dump and return your cart(s) to the curb. In order to facilitate this change, a 96-gallon wheeled trash cart, like the one in the photo to the right, will be delivered to your residence along with a 96-gallon wheeled cart for collection of all your single-stream recyclable items.



96-gallon cart

Remember, single-stream recycling allows you to place all recyclable commodities, such as paper, cardboard, steel, plastic, tin, aluminum and glass, into one collection cart. Single-stream recycled items require loose placement within the collection cart.

The 96-gallon cart weighs 30.3 pounds when empty and is very easy to maneuver over multiple types of terrain.

In order to assist persons with physical conditions or medical problems and who do not have anyone to help them with their chores, the Village of Kewaskum will exempt such persons from the required use of the 96-gallon wheeled household garbage and recycling carts by allowing the continued use of manual collection for garbage and recycleables.

Qualified residents must:

1. Be unable to wheel their cart to the curb for collection.
2. Have no one else who can assist them, such as a spouse or other live-in family member or a personal assistant.
3. Be certified by a physician as needing assistance.
4. Fill out and return the required request for exemption form. (Page 1)
