

The Kewaskum Village Board, Washington County, Wisconsin met in special session in the Council Room of the Municipal Building, 204 First Street.

Gitter called the meeting of the Village Board to order at 7:00 p.m., followed by roll call and a reading of the Affidavit of Posting for the meeting.

Motion by Wright, seconded by Weninger to nominate Knoebel as Chairperson Pro-tem, voice vote, motion carried.

A moment of silence and the Pledge of Allegiance were observed.

**PUBLIC HEARING** – Knoebel opened the public hearing on levying special assessments for the benefits conferred upon property by the improvements of Fond du Lac Avenue. M. Leisses, Village Engineer, presented on the Water and Sanitary Sewer Lateral Reconstruction.

T. Nichols (1546 Fond du Lac), J. Leicht (1129 & 1133 Fond du Lac), R. Wilson (1416 Fond du Lac), R. Gremminger (1235 Fond du Lac), M. Beyer (1623 Fond du Lac), Mike Dickmann (1245 Fond du Lac) inquired and expressed concerns on the project and special assessments. Motion by Hovland, seconded by Wright to close public hearing, voice vote, motion carried.

Motion by Weninger, seconded by Wright to award Fond du Lac Avenue bid to Vinton Construction Company, voice vote, motion carried.

Motion by Hovland, seconded by Weninger to offer a five-year payment plan at 5% interest for the special assessment, voice vote, motion carried.

Motion by Wright, seconded by Hovland to approve Resolution 2024-02 Preliminary Resolution Declaring Intent to Levy Special Assessments, voice vote, motion carried. Consensus of board to offer a five (5) year payment plan at 5% interest for the special assessments.
