Village Board
Meeting Minutes
June 3, 2020, 4:00 PM

The Kewaskum Village Board, Washington County, Wisconsin met in special session at the Kewaskum Annex Building, 1308 Fond du Lac Avenue.

President Scheunemann called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. Board members present were Richard Laubach, Sarah Severance, Dave Spenner, Jim Wright, Jim Hovland, Richard Knoebel and Kevin Scheunemann. Staff members present: Administrator Matt Heiser, DPW Working Foreman Dennis Aupperle, Police Chief Tom Bishop, Fire Chief Mark Groeschel, and Clerk Tammy Butz. Members from the community and the news media were also present.

Notice of the meeting had been posted at PNC Bank, Kewaskum Post Office and at the Municipal Building on Tuesday, June 2, 2020. Notice was also forwarded to the Village Board, Village Attorney and the news media.

NEW BUSINESS

President Scheunemann opened discussion to reconsider the July 3rd fireworks action of June 1, 2020. Motion by Trustee Wright to reconsider, seconded by Trustee Knoebel, motion carried by roll call vote: Hovland – aye, Wright – aye, Spenner -aye, Severance – aye, Knoebel – aye, Laubach – aye, Scheunemann – aye (7-0).

President Scheunemann opened discussion on the July 3rd Fireworks. Discussion ensued on the pros and cons of launching at Reigle Park versus River Hill Park and public comment was received by three residents. Trustee Knoebel motioned to have the July 3rd Fireworks with launch point at Reigle Park and to empower Village Staff to define plan, seconded by President Scheunemann, motion carried by roll call vote: Severance – aye, Knoebel – aye, Laubach – abstain, Hovland – aye, Wright – aye, Spenner – abstain, Scheunemann – aye (5-0-2).

Trustee Knoebel motioned to adjourn at 4:33, seconded by Trustee Severance, motion carried by roll call vote: Knoebel – aye, Laubach – aye, Hovland – aye, Wright – aye, Spenner – aye, Severance – aye, Scheunemann – aye (7-0).
