- XIII. Hear written objections
 - a) Taxpayers sworn in, present oral testimony, and written information specifying value and method
 - b) Assessor is sworn in and presents oral testimony
 - c) Board of Review members examine all knowledgeable individuals
- XIV. Deliberation and action on objections heard (roll call vote required)
- XV. Notice of determination prepared
- XVI. Schedule hearings for written objections filed but not heard
- XVII. Adjourn or adjourn to another date if all objections are not heard (roll call vote required)
